Bellaire City Council Meeting - September 17

Bellaire City Council considered action regarding the following:

- Award of construction-related contracts for the Group D Phase 1 sidewalk program.

City Council Action:

The Bellaire City Council decided to proceed with the construction and construction management contracts for the Group D Phase 1 project with the exception that streets identified in this project located outside Loop 610 will not receive sidewalks. The streets identified in this project that are located inside Loop 610 will have 4' sidewalks replaced or installed on one side of the street.
