



Risk Assessment

The Completed Hazard/Risk Assessment to be reviewed by the Task Force should describe the local flooding hazard, and included the following Problem Areas:

- Flooding Sources
- Frequency of Flooding
- Flood-prone Areas (Repetitive Loss Areas)
- Severity of Flooding (Depth)

These Risk Categories should be outlined by the following:

- Local
 - Streets Flooding
 - Utility Flooding
 - Communications
 - Emergency Operations
 - Economic Impacts (Effects on Real-estate)
- Regulatory
 - Building Code
 - Design Standards
 - Define Codes
- Regionally
 - Impact of Project Brays on City of Bellaire
 - State & County Hazard Mitigation Plans (Flooding Impacts on Bellaire)

Mitigation Plan

The Mitigation Plan should develop a strategy for reducing the potential losses identified in the risk assessment, and include goals and objectives.

The goals and objectives identified should:

- Clarify Problems and Issues
- Determine what should be focused on locally, regulatorily, and regionally
- Propose solutions to solve problems associated with identified risks

Action Plan

The Action Plan should provide tangible solutions for achieving the goals and objectives outlined in the Mitigation Plan.
