1983

\$8 million Resolution No. 83-19 (calling bond election for November 8, 1983 on three propositions: sanitary sewer system improvements in the amount of \$4,000,000; waterworks system improvements in the amount of \$2,000,000; and roads, bridges, and streets improvements, including related drainage facilities, in the amount of \$2,000,000); and

Resolution No. 83-22 (canvassing bond election; all propositions passed).

1985

\$8.5 million Resolution No. 85-10 (calling bond election for November 5, 1985 on one proposition: roads, bridges and streets, including, but not by way of limitation, related drainage facilities, related traffic control devices and the acquisition of rights-of-way in the amount of \$8,500,000); and

Resolution No. 85-16 (canvassing bond election; proposition failed).

1988

\$8 million Ordinance No. 88-054 (calling bond election for February 11, 1989 on three propositions: sanitary sewer improvements in the amount of \$4,500,000; waterworks system improvements in the amount of \$2,500,000; and street improvements and related drainage in the amount of \$1,000,000); and

Ordinance No. 89-003 (canvassing bond election; all propositions passed).

1992

\$10 million Ordinance No. 92-044 (calling bond election for August 8, 1992 on one proposition: sanitary sewer improvements and waterworks system improvements in the amount of \$10,000,000); and

Ordinance No. 92-065 (canvassing bond election; proposition passed).

2000

\$45 million Ordinance No. 00-067 (calling bond election for November 7, 2000 on two propositions: water system, sanitary sewer system, and drainage improvements in the amount of \$23,066,175; and street improvements in the amount of \$21,933,825); and

Ordinance No. 00-108 (canvassing bond election; propositions passed).

2005

\$50 million Ordinance No. 05-057 (calling bond election for November 8, 2005 on two propositions: street, sidewalk and drainage improvements in the amount of \$41,000,000; and improvements to municipal buildings and facilities to wit, police station, municipal court, library, city hall, Bellaire municipal pool, fire station, and to acquire additional land for such in the amount of \$9,000,000); and

Ordinance No. 05-079 (canvassing bond election; propositions passed).

2013

\$16.5 million Ordinance No. 13-044 (calling bond election for November 5, 2013 on four propositions: improvements to municipal building and facilities, to wit, city hall, civic center, police station and municipal courts buildings in the amount of \$11,000,000; acquisition of land and relocation of municipal facilities, to wit, city hall, civic center, police station and municipal courts buildings, if proposition one is approved in the amount of \$5,000,000; construction of improvements at Evelyn's Park in the amount of \$5,000,000; and improvements to The Nature Discovery Center building and grounds in Russ Pitman Park in the amount of \$500,000); and

Ordinance No. 13-056 (canvassing bond election; three propositions passed, and one proposition failed.
The failed proposition was related to the acquisition of land and relocation of municipal facilities).

2016

\$54 million Ordinance No. 16-046 (calling bond election for November 8, 2016 on three propositions: streets, drainage and sidewalk improvements in the amount of \$24,000,000; construction of municipal buildings, to wit, city hall/civic center and police/courts building in the amount of \$5,600,000; and water and wastewater improvements in the amount of \$24,380,000); and

Ordinance No. 16-068 (canvassing bond election; propositions passed).
